Student surveys during school hours

Occasionally, schools gather information regarding students' outlook, mostly on the grounds of the school performing a self-assessment or in order to implement improvements. In recent years, such surveys have generally concerned themselves with the communication and well-being of students. Furthermore, under certain circumstances, the resulting information may be processed without anonymity to provide mapping of social standings and well-being—with a final goal of implementing improvements. Student travelling with school employee in employee's personal vehicle

On occasion, as a direct result of school activities, a school employee might need to transport a student in the employee's personal vehicle. This might be the case if a student is incapable of bicycling/walking during outdoors field trips or field studies, if a student suffers minimal injuries and needs to be transported home or to the emergency room (in the case parents being out of reach), if a student has to be driven home in severe weather, if a student misses the school bus to swimming lessons, or due to other unforeseen circumstances. With this signature, the child's guardian gives their consent to their child travelling with a school employee in the employee's personal vehicle—if circumstances dictate such an action to be necessary.
